Things you need to know during your stay at America's Keswick...

- 1. America's Keswick is a drug, alcohol, smoke and e-cigg <u>free</u> ministry. This applies to the entire campus. Thank you for your cooperation.
- 2. Please dress appropriately for a Bible conference, so that you feel comfortable and relaxed. Keswick, however, has certain rules about what is not allowed: very low-cut blouses, blouses with spaghetti straps or short shirts that reveal the stomach exposed, and very short shorts. As for bathing suits, two-piece bikinis or revealing swimsuits are not permitted. A one-piece modest swimsuit for women and swim trunks for men are the acceptable attire. Please wear sandals or shoes at all times to avoid accidents. People who are not dressed appropriately will be asked to change their clothes.
- 3. Quiet hours are from 11:00 PM to 7:00 AM in all areas on campus. Please respect the other guests.
- 4. **Please wear your name tag during your stay.** It is necessary to enter the pool and the dining room, and to gain access to all activities and recreational facilities. When the conference ends please keep your name tag as a memory of your time here and remember to pray for the ministry of America's Keswick.
- 5. Athletic equipment is available at the Activity Center. Activities available in-clude shuffleboard, horseshoes, basketball, volleyball, racquetball, walleyball, ping pong, canoeing (Memorial Day-Labor Day), bocce, and fishing (catch & release). We also have a brand new golf putting green (equipment is located at the Raws Front Desk). Helmets must be worn by anyone under 17 years old using bicycles, skateboards, rollerblades or scooters.
- 6. Please turn off (or turn to vibrate) all cell telephones during the morning and evening sessions. *This is VERY important and we thank you for your help.*



New Year's Dinner Concert Monday, December 31, 2018 with Damaris Carbaugh


