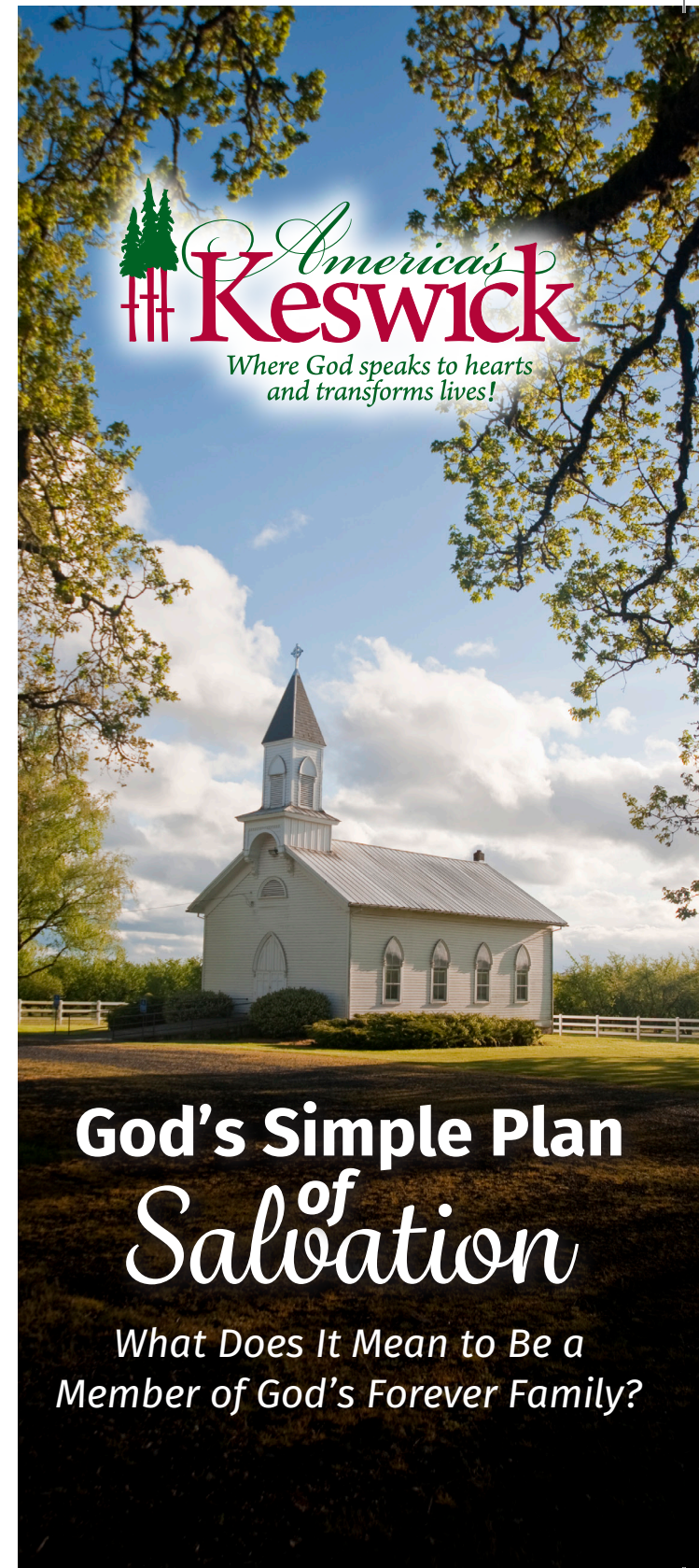

God's Simple Plan of Salvation

1. Realize you are a sinner:

"For all have sinned and come short of the glory of God." Romans 3:23

2. Repent of all sin:

(Repentance is turning to God)

"The Lord is not slow in keeping His promise, as some understand slowness. Instead He is patient with you, not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance."

2 Peter 3:9

3. Recognize the payment for sin:

"... and He Himself bore our sins in His body on the cross, so that we might die to sin and live to righteousness ..." 1 Peter 2:24

4. Remember God loves you:

"But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us." Romans 5:8

5. Receive forgiveness of sin:

"For whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be saved." Romans 10:13

6. Will you pray this prayer of salvation?

Dear God, I confess that I have sinned and done wrong. I believe that your Son, Jesus Christ, took the punishment that I deserve by dying on the cross and I thank You. I also believe that You raised Him from the dead. I now receive Jesus as my Savior and Lord. Amen

You made the most important decision you could ever make by trusting Jesus Christ as your personal Lord and Savior and we are so thrilled that you are a part of God's forever family.

Now here are some practical things that you can do to help you as you begin your new life with Christ:

1. Read God's Word every day. If you don't have access to a Bible, please let us know and we will get you a copy. Read God's Word systematically. Start with the Gospel of John, and with a pen or highlighter, underline the verses that speak to your heart.

2. Pray every day. God delights when His children pray. Don't get hung up on trying to figure out the mechanics of praying – just pray.

Pray before reading the Bible. Ask the Holy Spirit to teach you.

Pray for guidance for your day.

Pray when you need comfort.

Pray when you are conscious of sin in your life.

Pray when you are in need of peace.

Pray back Scriptures to Him from His Word.

3. Journal what God is teaching you as you read His Word and pray. Journaling is a good way to see how you are growing in your walk with the Lord.

4. Find a local church and get connected. The church has been established by God to help us grow, to provide fellowship and nurturing, and to provide accountability. As you grow in your relationship with the Lord, He will place in you a desire to serve Him in the local church.
