

Keswick Homeschool Ko-op Dress Code

Our goal is to maintain a respectful, modest, and distraction-free environment that reflects Christian values. Students, parents, and volunteers are asked to follow these guidelines during ko-op activities and events.

General Standards

- Clothing should be **clean, neat, and modest.**
- Outfits should be **appropriate for a family-friendly Christian environment.**
- Undergarments should **not be visible** at any time.
- Clothing should **fit comfortably without being excessively tight or oversized.**

Tops

- Shirts must **cover the midriff.**
- Tank tops and sleeveless shirts must have **straps at least 2 inches wide.**
- Graphic tees are permitted **as long as designs and wording are wholesome.**
 - **Not permitted:** imagery or text with profanity, violence, occult (death, devils) symbols, drug or alcohol references, or inappropriate suggestive content.
 - **Encouraged:** positive, uplifting, or neutral imagery (nature, sports, Scripture, etc.).

Bottoms

- Shorts, skirts, and dresses must be **no shorter than 3 inches above the knee.**
- Leggings or athletic tights may be worn **only with a top that fully covers the seat.**
- Pants should be free from rips or tears **above the knee.**

Enforcement

- Repeated dress code violations will result in the following: **1st time = Verbal warning & discussion with parent/guardian, 2nd = Written warning & a formal meeting with parent/guardian, 3rd = Meeting to discuss removal from program participation.**
